E-Mobility: Energie 360° Acquires Move Mobility, Strengthens Leading Position in Switzerland

Effective immediately, Energie 360° has acquired charging provider Move Mobility. This merger strengthens the position of Energie 360°'s mobility group as a leader in Swiss e-mobility. The group, which includes the brands Energie 360°, Gofast, Swisscharge, and Move Mobility, will now offer over 24,000 public and private charging points across all Swiss regions and serve 250,000 users. Starting November 1, 2025, all roaming fees within the Energie 360° mobility group's charging network will be eliminated.

As Switzerland's leading mobility group, Energie 360° is solidifying its position as number one in the EV charging market. With the acquisition of Move Mobility from [Primeo Energie](#) and [Groupe E](#), the number of charging points increases by 4,700 to over 24,000 total. The user base grows by 50,000 to more than 250,000. Energie 360° is fully integrating Move Mobility and its employees into its mobility group, while keeping the brand identity, as it does with its other brands. The company also gains permits from the Federal Roads Office (FEDRO) to build and operate charging hubs at around 40 highway rest stops.

The company plans to invest CHF 200 million by 2030 to expand its charging network.
